IRS OFFERS ADVANCE CHILD TAX CREDIT PAYMENTS THIS SUMMER

Beginning on July 15, 2021, changes to the Child Tax Credit will help families get advance payments on their child tax credit. The IRS will pay half the total credit amount in advance monthly payments, and the other half will be given when the 2021 income tax return is filed.
